Grade School Facilitator

Opportunity:

The Community for Interfaith Celebration is seeking a dynamic, spiritually-oriented leader to facilitate grade school programs with the help of contributing parents. This class room facilitator will provide CIC grade schoolers (grades K-4) with spiritual guidance, a feeling of community both within and outside of CIC, as well as a fun, safe and welcoming environment.

The Community for Interfaith Celebration is an interfaith congregation that values community, tolerance, and openness. We are coming from and turning to a variety of religious traditions, including: Christian, Jewish, Buddhist, Sufi, Quaker, Earth-centered, Unitarian, and Agnostic.

Position Responsibilities:

The grade school leader will:

- Facilitate grade school class time using curriculum or lesson plan idea prepared by volunteering parents, Sundays evenings September through June (5:00-6:45 for set up, class time, and clean up).
 - 5:00-5:20 Read plan for the evening, set up activity and distribute snack
 - 5:20-5:40 Welcome children, check in and have snack
 - 5:40-6:15 Activity
 - 6:15-6:20 Clean up time with kids
 - 6:20-6:30 Candle lighting
- Be encouraged, but not required, to participate in grade school planning meetings (approximately 3x year).
- Help organize and be available for grade school community services projects.
- Communicate with Youth and Children's Program Coordinator

Hours and Compensation:

The position will require approximately 8 hours per month, in addition to the planning meetings. The pay begins at \$12/hour. Hours are recorded as they are worked and turned in monthly to the coordinator.

Qualities:

The preferred candidate will be energetic and fun-loving. He or she will be effective and comfortable communicating with children from diverse religious backgrounds. He or she will be confident following a prepared lesson plan and will possess good time management skills.

Interview Process:

Candidates will be contacted no later than November 8, 2009 with a scheduled time to come down to the United Churches for an interview with the hiring committee.
