The Community for Interfaith Celebration (CIC) is an interfaith congregation that values community, tolerance, and openness. We are coming from and turning to a variety of religious traditions, including: Christian, Jewish, Buddhist, Sufi, Quaker, Earth-centered, Unitarian, and Agnostic.

Position Description:

The Youth Group Leader will mentor and nurture spiritual growth in CIC youth by:

- Planning for and facilitating interfaith exploration and celebration activities with a group of teens most Sunday evenings, September through June (4:30-7:00 for planning, celebration, and follow-up).
- Participating in youth group planning meetings (approximately 3 times per year).
- Helping organize and be available for youth group activities and community services projects that may happen outside of Sunday evenings.
- Developing program curriculum.
- Attending twice-yearly community weekend retreats at Fort Flagler State Park (Encouraged, but not required- May and September).
- Collaborating with parents, youth, and other community members in curriculum development and activity planning.

The position will work approximately 14 hours per month (140 hours per year), in addition to the two optional retreats.

Experience:

The preferred candidate will have experience working with adolescents in settings that could include teaching, church youth groups, experiential, wilderness or challenge course activities, community service, youth camps, or counseling.

Qualities:

The preferred candidate will be an energetic, fun-loving, spiritual seeker. He or she will be effective and comfortable communicating with adolescents and adults from diverse religious backgrounds, and will have a strong desire and ability to facilitate exploration of a wide variety of spiritual faiths and practices in a way that keeps youth involved and interested, and contributes to their spiritual growth.
